SOUND POLLUTION PETITION

According to the WHO (World Health Organisation) and Health Canada, noises exceeding 45 decibels can affect the sleep and concentration of children. During the day, some neighbors may also be sleeping because they work nights, others may be sick, on vacation, retired, etc... It was noted that the overwhelming majority of car locking « beeps » exceed 4 to 32 times the acceptable 45 decibels norm.

The undersigned have agreed to reduce sound pollution that can affect sleep and concentration of children at your daycare by eliminating noisy car locking « beeps » emited by their cars.

The undersigned are kindly asking the daycare management to help distribute folders and to post a sign to allow the employees and parents to take notice of this sound pollution.
